



Mabel Rogene Reynolds

June 28, 1921 - March 28, 2016

Mabel “Rogene” Reynolds, 94, passed away peacefully on March 28, 2016 at home in Folsom, California. She was born June 28, 1921 on a farm in Canton, Illinois, the second of three daughters to the late Adolph and Corlieu Lutticken.

Rogene attended Woodruff High School, making lifelong friends and graduated with honors in 1939.
